

DAY 1: DINNER AT HOTEL

Location: Fairmont Kea Lani Hotel

DAY 2: JEEP TOUR ON ROAD TO HANA

This 64.4 mile stretch of winding, scenic road starts in Kahului and takes visitors to the town of Hana. Stop at one of the many mile markers along the way to go for a hike, and take in waterfalls and scenic outlooks. 600 hairpin turns and 46 one-lane bridges make up the drive.

One of the first stops on the Road to Hana is Twin Falls. Make a stop at Mile Marker 2, where you'll see the farm stand to the right of Hana Highway. Enjoy a leisurely hike to one of the two falls, where you can enjoy swimming, scenery, or rock jumping.

Leave before 8am, to see as many attractions on the drive as possible before making the trip back to Wailea.

DAY 2: ADVENTURE OPTION: RAPELLING WATERFALLS

Located halfway down the famous Hana Highway, you can enjoy a curious mix of peace and excitement and rappel down into wild, inspiring, raw nature. Your experience takes place in a privately-owned, secluded waterfall valley, one of the few tour destinations of its kind. Get away from it all: The crowds, the traffic, the pace. Experience the sounds of nature in a more intimate, personal paradise of rainforests, waterfalls, pools and streams.

No previous climbing or rappelling experience is necessary, and all gear is provided; beginners welcome.

DAY 2: HELICOPTER TOUR

Experience a Maui helicopter ride unlike any other during the Hana Rainforest Experience. Explore Maui's authentic and remote landscape featuring an exclusive 30-minute landing within the Hawaiian Rainforest. Fly along Maui's North Coast with views of breathtaking sea cliffs and cascading waterfalls on your 40 minute roundtrip helicopter flight. Aerial shoreline perspectives above Paia, Hookipa, Haiku, the famous surf destination – JAWS, the Road to Hana and the iconic Jurassic Rock lead you to our exclusive landing destination deep in the Hawaiian rainforest.

HIGHLIGHT:

Descend and land for a ground exploration on a former taro plantation in the Wailua Valley. Traverse the lush vegetation including banana, coconut and wild flowers and indulge in scenic panoramic views as you are surrounded by canyons and waterfalls...a land which very few people have ever stepped foot on.

DAY 3: CATAMARAN SNORKELING ADVENTURE

Explore the unseen side of Maui on an adventure beneath the sea. This custom built luxury sailing catamaran will take you to the small, crescent shaped island of Molokini off the southwestern coast of Maui. The waters and colorful reefs here are so rich with life, Molokini was named a State Marine Life and Bird Conservation District. You will see colorful fish, sea turtles and coral formations.

DAY 3: OUTRIGGER CANOE TOUR

Whether it's your first or fiftieth time to Maui, it's never too late to try something new. Combine a thrilling ocean adventure, including snorkeling, whale watching or even canoe surfing, with fascinating information about Hawaiian culture and endemic marine life. This is absolutely one of our favorite ocean activities on Maui. The modern Hawaiian Outrigger Canoe or Wa`a is where ancient Hawaiian Culture and modern technology mix. In ancient days wooden Wa`a were used for transportation, fishing, voyaging and sport for chiefs or Ali`i. Today modern fiberglass design allows for a more stable, performance based canoe

Explore a tour of Maui's agricultural beauty exploring organic farms, ranches, gardens, farmer's markets, native plant botanical gardens, five hundred year old taro farms, micro green growers, beekeepers and coffee growers.

DAY 4: EXCURSION SUNRISE HALEAKALA

Experience one of the world's most beautiful and unique sunrise spots on this unforgettable morning excursion. Atop the famous Haleakala Crater, the highest peak on the island of Maui, you will witness an explosion of color as the sun rises above the clouds. This rare opportunity to view paradise from this altitude will be the highlight of your stay. Take the bus down and a stop at a local favorite for a delicious breakfast on the trip down. Optional: Experience a self guided 23 mile bike ride down the volcano through the world's most spectacular scenery.





DAY 4: HORSEBACK RIDE

The island of Maui offers some of Hawaii's most memorable horseback riding adventures. First-time riders and skilled equestrians alike can choose from a number of trail rides that include visits to the island's most famous locations. Trail rides are available throughout Maui—from Kapalua in West Maui and Makena in South Maui all the way to Hana—and offer a diverse array of experiences: through a tropical rainforest, along cliffs overlooking the Pacific Ocean, into Haleakala Crater, up into Hana's scenic highlands, onto the Upcountry ranchlands and beyond.

DAY 4: LUAU DINNER

Experience one of Hawaii's most celebrated traditions within one of the most magnificent settings at Four Seasons Resort Hualalai, the Hoku Amphitheater.

The evening begins with a short stroll along a candlelit, flowered path to your private dinner table, set on the amphitheater's stage and framed by the venue's dramatic lava-carved terraces. Tiki torches, white Chinese lanterns and twinkling stars (hoku is Hawaiian for "star") light the night sky as you watch our chef prepare a personalised five-course meal, some cooked in a traditional imu (underground oven). Sip wine pairings offered by our sommelier and enjoy a tableside serenade by local musicians. If you're inspired to join in and dance, the stage is yours.

Dinner is followed with dramatic, traditional performances by hula and fire dancers. And the night's festivities are professionally documented with photography and video, so you can relive the experience long after you say aloha.
