DAY 1 FREE DAY AT LEISURE AT THE HOTEL OR OPTIONAL: HALF DAY TOUR PAPHOS

Today guests will have the chance to relax and enjoy the services of the all inclusive at the hotel. Alternatively they can join us for a half day Tour to Paphos. If they take this option right after lunch have to be ready to meet the town where they are accommodated. The area of Kato Pafos is under the protection of UNESCO. First, there will be a visit at the Tombs of the Kings which are underground Tombs carved out of solid rock and date back to the century BC. Then, we continue to the Archaeological Park of the town, which includes the "House of Dionysos" and the guests will admire a series of beautifully preserved mosaics depicting scenes from the Greek Mythology. Free time will be given for the guests to enjoy the picturesque harbour of Pafos before returning to the hotel.




DAY 2 JEEP TOUR AKAMAS PENINSULA

Right after breakfast, the guests will hop on Land Rover Defender Jeeps at the hotel and will have a fun and interesting day. They will have the chance to discover the mysterious and unexplored territory of Akamas Peninsula. The area is unique, as it is the last coastal region on the island of Cyprus to remain largely untouched by mass tourism and development. There will be a visit at the Lara Bay – one of the last breeding grounds for the large Green–Backed Turtles. Moving on towards the edge of the Northern Peninsula, the guests will visit the Baths of Aphrodite where, according to legend, Aphrodite bathed with her lover Adonis.

After an adventurous morning and before proceeding to lunch, there will be a visit at a local winery where the guests will be given the opportunity to have a wine tasting and be guided at the winery. Lunch will be offered afterwards at a local tavern of the area before returning to the hotel.

DAY 3 CRUISE ALONG THE COAST OF LIMASSOL (WEATHER PERMITTING)

After breakfast, the guests will travel to the city of Limassol, where they will get aboard for a 6 hours private cruise along the coast of Limassol (10:00-16:00hrs). They will have the chance to enjoy cruising on the crystal clear waters of the Mediterranean Sea and also swim at different bays where the catamaran will be stopping. On board, the guestswill enjoy an open bar and a buffet lunch and can also dance with the tunes of a DJ music. Ending with the cruise, there will be given some short free time to the guests to walk in the old city of Limassol and the new Marina of Limassol which is the new jewel of the city. Return to the hotel.



DAY 4 TOUR AND TRANSFER TO THE AIRPORT

After breakfast, the guests will check out and will proceed for a tour to the outskirts of Limassol as well to the villages of Larnaca before being transferred to Larnaca airport for their departure (flight departs at 20:40hrs). The first visit of this tour will be at Petra tou Romiou (Aphrodite's Rock)... According to the mythology, the Goddess of Love and Beauty, Aphrodite, was born from the foam of the sea at this spot. Then, we proceed to the outskirts of Limassol, where there will be a visit at at the Ancient Site of Curium. Curium was an ancient city-kingdom and it's one of the most important archaeological sites of the island. The magnificent Greco-Roman Theatre with its breathtaking view, originally built in the 2nd century BC, is now fully restored and is used for musical and theatrical performances. Within the area, the group will visit the House of Eustolios with its stunning 5th century mosaics.





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Next, there will be a visit at the village of Lefkara. The village is very picturesque and also well known for its handmade lace and silverware. The guests will have the chance to stroll within the village and enjoy also its unique architecture. The next stop will be at the **museum of Bee and Embroidery** at the village of Kato Drys, right next to Lefkara village. The museum is housed in a 300 year old residence and features exhibits that show the daily life of the villagers through the ages including farming and household equipment. The museum is also related to bees and local beekeeping practices. There, they will be offered honey to taste and also a traditional sweet. The lunch, will be offered to a local winery in the area. Apart from the lunch, the guests will have a show round of the winery and have also a wine tasting. After the lunch, the group will be transferred to Larnaca airport for its departure (arrival at airport at 18:30hrs).
