
Portuguese vineyards are the 8th largest in the world, with 224 thousand hectares, and we are the 9th biggest wine exporter in the world.

Port Wine was born and is exclusively produced in the Douro region, one of the 14 wine regions in Portugal. Douro is the oldest demarcated wine region in the world and was declared World Heritage by UNESCO in 2001. It offers unique and incomparable beauty and today is one of the most visited wine regions in the world.

Port Wine has been the main ambassador of the Portuguese wines for a long time, but the world is beginning to discover that there are a lot more wines produced here. Portugal produces great rose, white, rose, red, and sparkling wines.
