

magnificent beach and garden area.


A total of 402 rooms & 23 meeting spaces for up to 600 people.

The 'Archipencos' is a traditional part of the celebrations during carnival time. The locals turn out in force to see the valiant, and not so valiant, attempts to travel from the beach (regatta style race). The vessels are each individually designed around an own particular theme, and are powered by the efforts of the crew, with a little help, or hindrance from the wind. This activity allows you to enjoy the carnival and ride in floating contraptions with carnival sailors participating in a very special race; the teams will have materials to build the boat, as well as the possibility of designing their own costumes. Furthermore, a Batucada group to cheer the teams up for the race, make-up artists on site or artists such as fire jugglers to roam around the beach & assist the teams can be incorporated.







If you are in Tenerife anytime from April to September consider yourself lucky since this is the season of Romerías – a traditional festival you can't miss.

On beautifully decorated carts, people hand out food and wine to the crowd. Some of the carts used to be pulled by oxen, cows or even mighty bulls (now they are adapted vehicles –normally big trucks) Herds of goats or sheep also take part in the parade & still do, while the people dress in traditional costumes of all colours there is music and dance everywhere and there's just a great atmosphere. Spain is known for celebrating fiestas like no other country but Romerías are special events even here, so...

## Why not create you own Romería?

The idea is to create a similar Canarian concept where we would dress food trucks with canarian elements to create the "cart" concept, wooden rustic tables & waiters dressed in Canarian clothing offering typical Canarian food, artisan beers as well as games & activities such as recognise local wines blindfolded, prepare traditional dishes like Gofio or Mojos, participate in traditional canarian dancing, have a try at Canarian wrestling &/or stick fighting, roll a cigar or even milk a goat. The possibilities are endless!

**CLIMATE – Tenerife and the Canary Islands are blessed with an all year round agreeable climate**
