Arrival in Ulaanbaatar, the capital city of Mongolia.


Traditional welcoming at the airport. Transfer to the hotel. Refreshment.

Day 3 Travel to Khongor Sand Dunes visit to nomads Travel to Khongor sand dunes. Known as Singing sand dunes, the Khongor dunes are up to 300m high, 15km wide, and 180km long. Enjoy a short hike through the Golden sand dunes. Climbing up to top of dunes and get an incredible view from top of the dunes. Lunch at the restaurant of the Ger camp. Afternoon you will visit a nomad family and can have a chance to see and learn about

authentic nomadic life. Enjoy Mongolian nomads' hospitality as you will be offered to drink milk tea and taste traditional dairy products made of camel cows' milk. Experience on riding of two humped Bactrian camel for an hour. Stay overnight in wooden house with ensuite bathroom at the "Gobi Erdene" Ger camp. **BLD**



Day 4 Travel to Bayanzag

Travel Khavtsgait, an area where ancient rock painting petroglyphs will be explored. Lunch at the restaurant of the Ger camp. Late afternoon you will be taken to Bayanzag, the world famous paleontological site of fossilized remains of ancient dinosaurs, had been discovered by American explorer Roy Chapmen Andrews. You will see saksaul forest in the

Gobi Desert and red flaming cliffs, which formed by the erosion of the sand and rock over many thousands of years. Hiking for an hour in the area. Travel back to Ger camp. Stay overnight in Ger with ensuite bathroom at the "Dream Gobi" Ger camp. BLD



Day 5 Travel to Ulaanbaatar & **National** Terelj park

Morning, transfer to the local airport and take a flight to Ulaanbaatar. Pick up and continue travel to Chinggis Khaan Statue complex. Visit the complex and inside museum. Move to Tereli National park. Short trip to the local landmark Turtle rock and Ariyabal temple. Stay overnight in Terelj Hotel.**** BLD



Day 6 Enjoy Naadam Festivity

This morning you will travel to Mongol Nomadic camp, takes 2hours drive. Here you will enjoy Nomadic cultural show including demonstrations by local people to give you authentic experiences of: - Learning a part of everyday life of herder family the - Making dairy products and tasting - Demonstration of the movement with ox cart and camel freight

- Making a felt sheet and tanning
- -Demonstration of national musical instrument and singing folk songs - Horseman show

Lunch at the restaurant of the Ger camp.

Afternoon you will enjoy "Naadam" festivity including Mongolian unique culture of three manly sports' competitions. The event will begin with a Mongolian long song and melody of horse head fiddle according to Mongolian tradition. Then strong wrestlers compete for the 1st round of the wrestling.



Archery competition and knuckle bone shooting competitions will be followed afterwards. You would be welcomed get real experience for archery and knuckle bone shooting. The horse racing will be started with young jockeys sing Giingoo - a special song/mantra for racing horses...

The winners of the competitions will be awarded with a sheep and other traditional gifts for nomads. You have opportunities to meet

with wrestlers, jockeys, archers and take memorable photos altogether. Late afternoon travel back to Ulaanbaatar. Shopping for cashmere and souvenirs.
