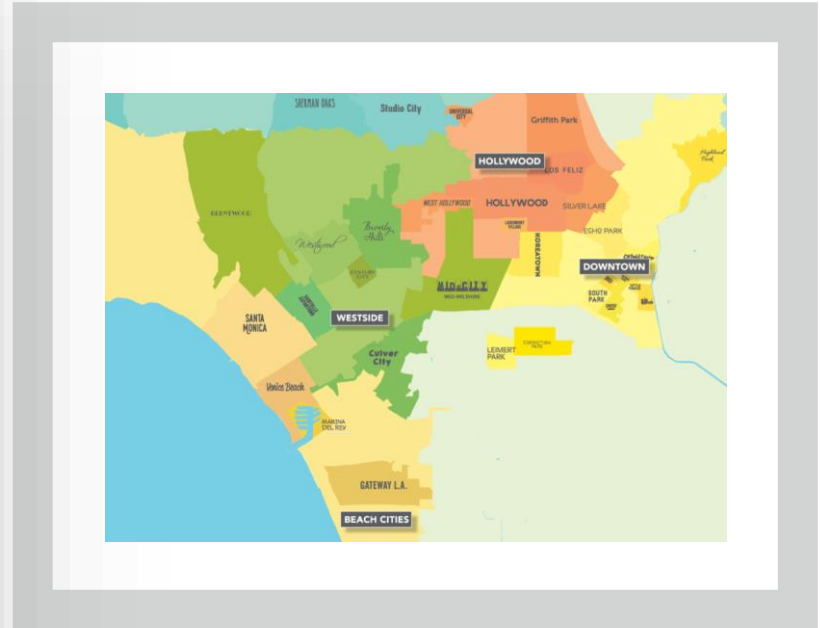

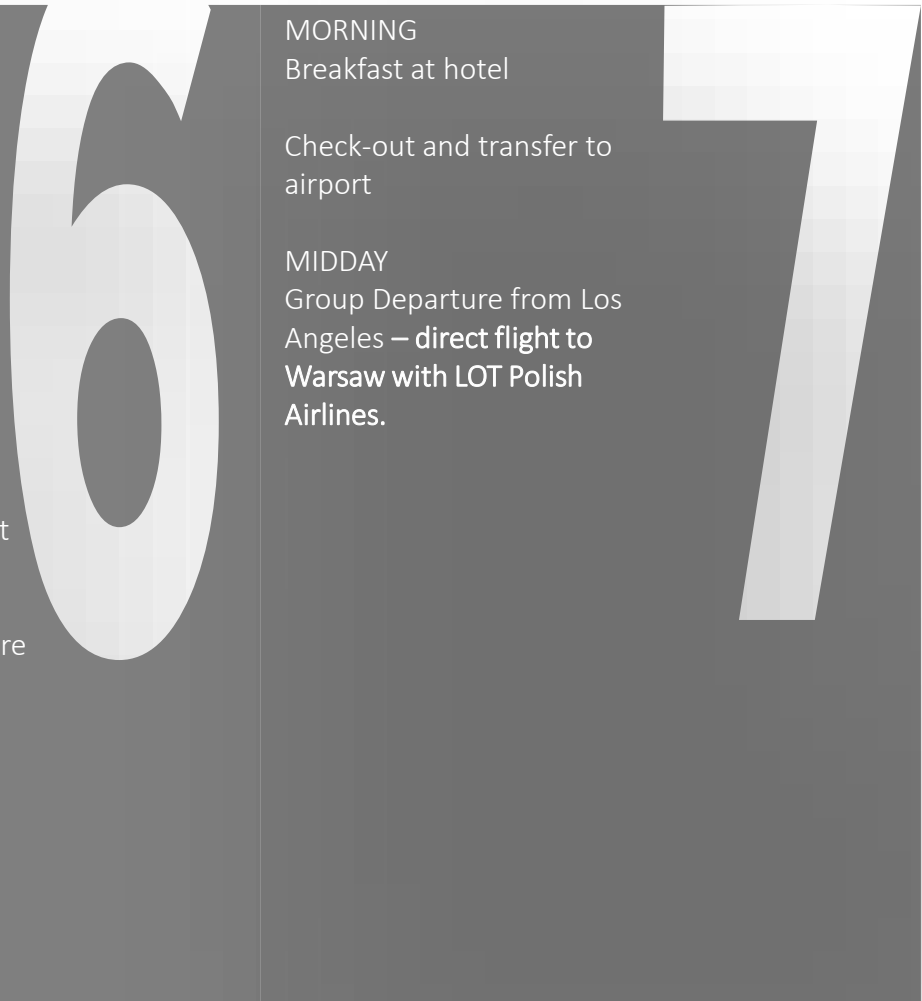

Vertical Networks, Santa Monica

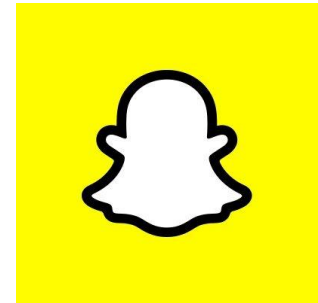

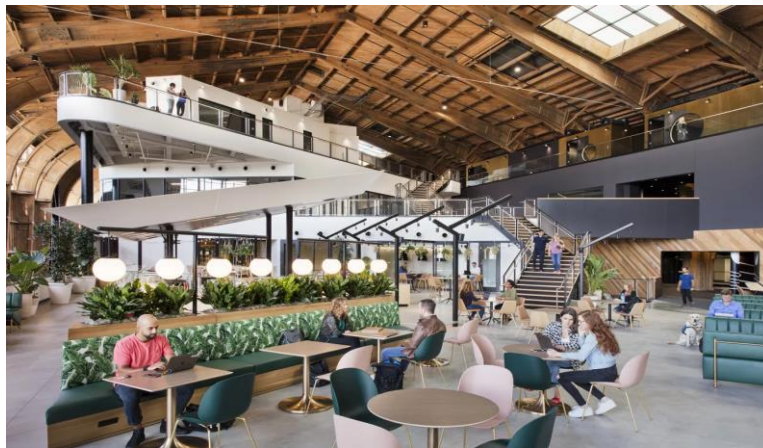

DAY 3: PETERSON AUTOMOTIVE MUSEUM

Following an extensive \$125-million renovation, the Petersen reopened in 2015. Designed by Kohn Pedersen Fox Associates, the striking new exterior wraps the museum with ribbons of stainless steel that evoke motion, speed and the lines of a bespoke automobile. One unique feature that separates the Petersen Automotive Museum from other automotive museums is the constantly rotating exhibit spaces. In the 100,000+ square feet that comprise The Petersen Automotive Museum, only about 150 vehicles are on display at any one time. The other half of the 300+ vehicle collection is in the museum's vault. The Vault is the Petersen's underground collection storage facility, home to cars representing 100 years of automotive history - many have rarely been seen by the public. Visitors can take a behind-the-scenes tour of this collection and get an intimate look at cars that aren't on display in the museum galleries.

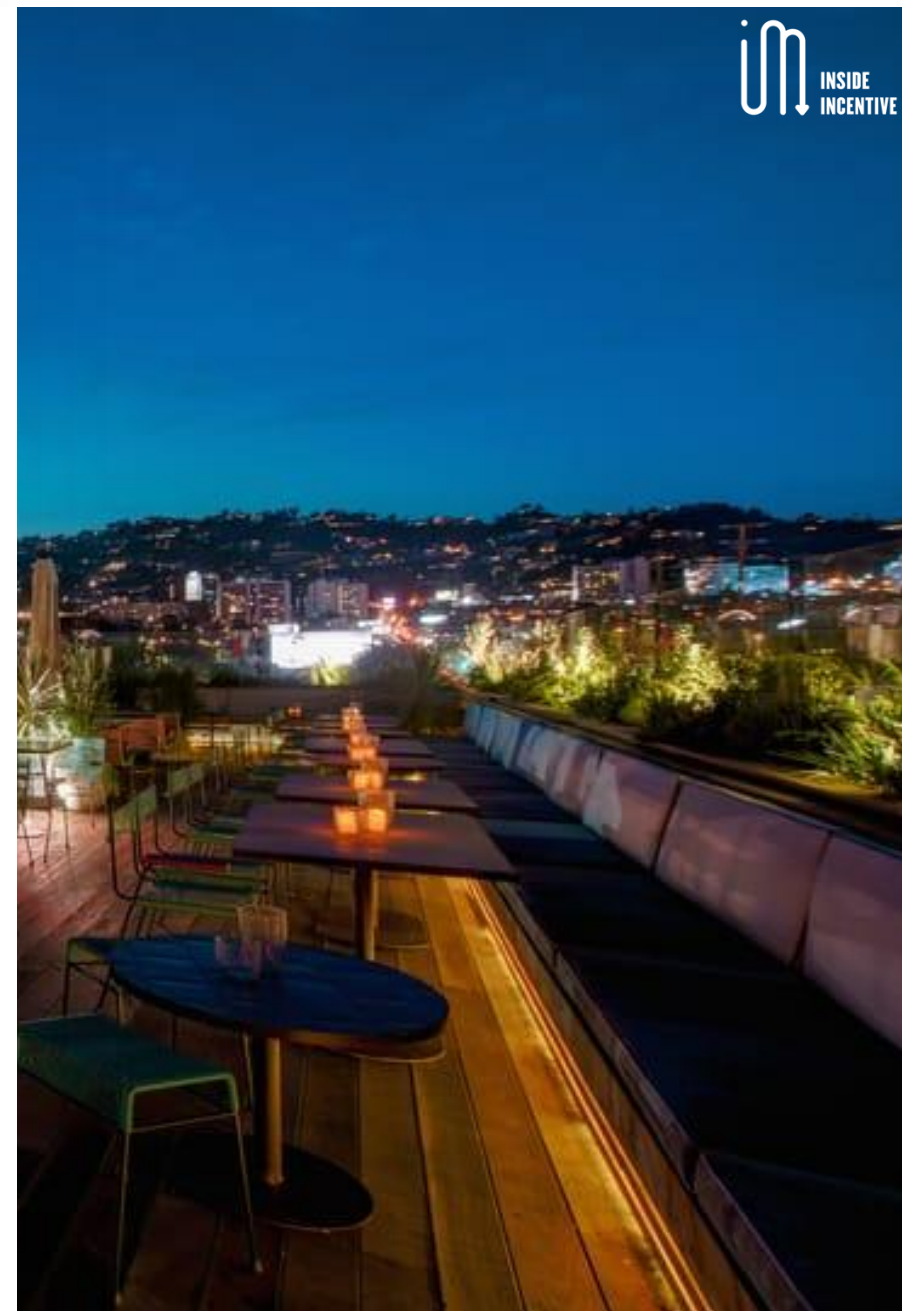

DAY 4: MALIBU WINE SAFARI

Explore the 1,000 acre Saddlerock Ranch and vineyard in Malibu. Your trusty guide and driver team will lead the adventure on custom-built open-air Safari vehicles. You'll make stops along the way to take in the scenery, taste local wines, and get up close and personal with animals you never knew were Angelinos too: zebras, camels, alpacas, bison, and even Stanley the Giraffe - all just 30 minutes from LA. From Bisous to Zinfandel, all wines are sourced from local vineyards, featuring the tastes and flavors of the casual wine-making culture alive in the Santa Monica Mountains. Many of the animals came to Saddlerock Ranch to retire after successful careers in Hollywood. Meet them in person and up close! From Timon and Pumba to Speeder and Shui, everyone on the Ranch welcomes you with open hooves. This is assuming you have a healthy handful of carrots, pellets, or bananas (provided).





DAY 4: GETTY VILLA

The museum complex includes a 450-seat outdoor classical theater, the villa, and a cafe.

It's like stepping back a couple of thousand years into a Roman-style villa. To be precise, it's a reproduction of the Villa dei Papiri; a first-century Roman country house unearthed at Herculaneum which was buried when Mt. Vesuvius erupted in A.D. 79.

See the villa's collection which is one of America's finest holdings of ancient Greek, Roman and Etruscan art. You'll see objects created over 7,000 years between the end of the Stone Age and the fall of the Roman Empire. Besides the artwork, the Getty Villa stages performances that include re-imagined versions of classic Greek and Roman dramas, as well as new and adapted works inspired by the museum's holdings or the ancient world

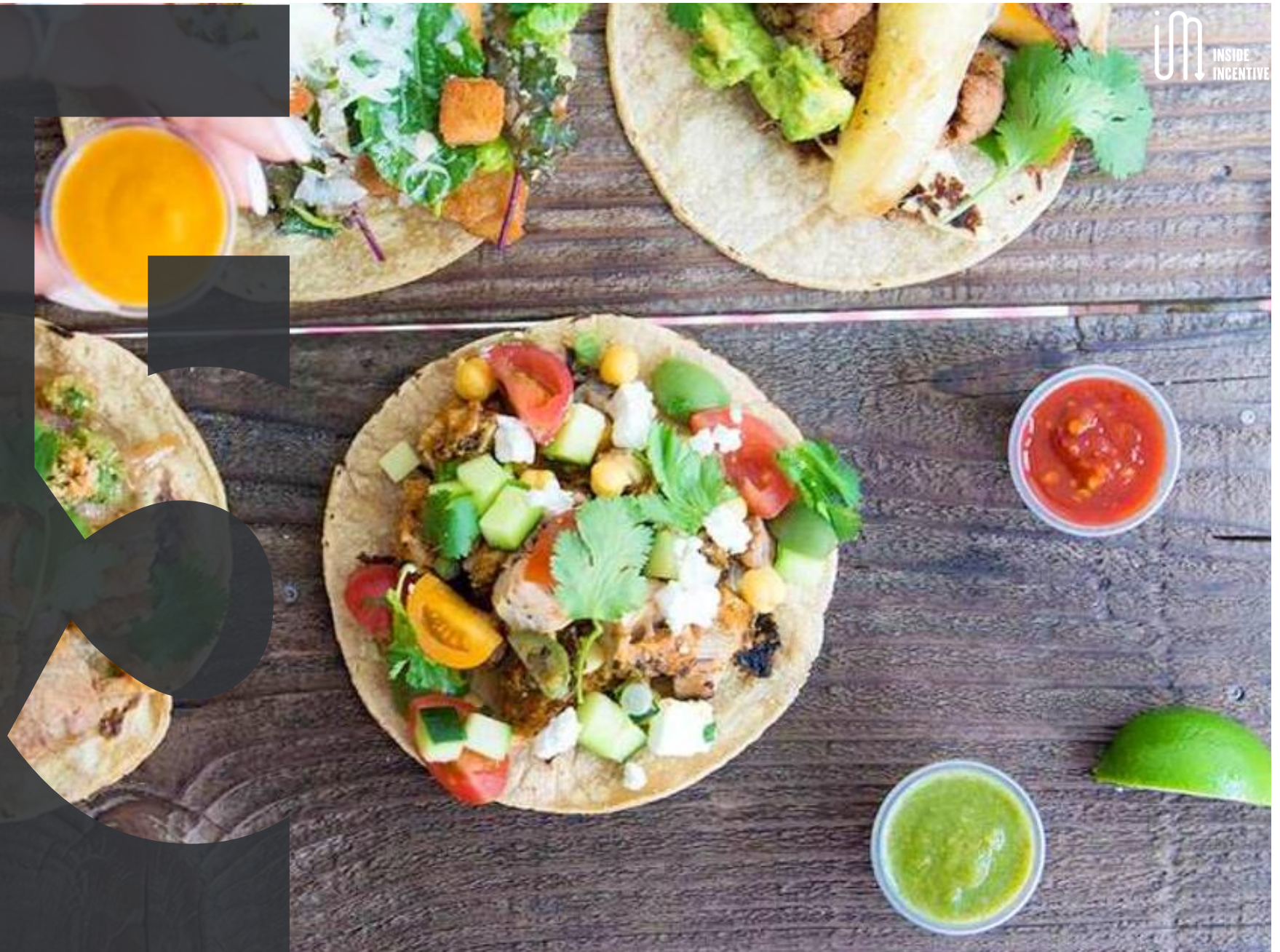


DAY 5: CULINARY TOUR IN DOWNTOWN LA

DAY 5: GRAFFITI ART LESSON & TOUR

The Los Angeles Graffiti and Mural scene- especially in Downtown LA- has been undergoing a renaissance the past few years, fueled by an absolutely amazing cadre of local artists, joined by some of the best from around the globe. Your guides take you into their own lofts and studios, down mural filled streets and graffiti filled alleys, and into unique creative art spaces of artists all over the Los Angeles region. The museum offers three floors of music memorabilia and interactive exhibits that educate and inspire guests on how music has shaped American culture. A favorite stop is the second-floor Clive Davis Theater, where everyone from Taylor Swift to Ringo Starr have performed!

Founded in December 2008, the GRAMMY Museum at L.A. LIVE celebrates the enduring legacies of all forms of music, the creative process, the art and technology of the recording process, and the history of the GRAMMY® Awards. The GRAMMY Museum educates visitors about the history and cultural significance of American music, and inspires the next generation to explore and create new forms of music using the roots that have existed in this country for centuries. The museum accomplishes this through innovative programming, cutting-edge interactive experiences, and exciting exhibitions.



DAY 5: EVENING NBA LA LAKERS

When it comes to pro basketball, STAPLES Center in Downtown is the center of the Los Angeles hoops universe. The Lakers are one of the most successful franchises in all of sports, with 16 championships, 24 Hall of Famers (17 players, 4 head coaches, 1 assistant coach, and 2 contributors), and a 33-game winning streak (1971-72 season) that is still the longest of any team in American professional sports. Under the ownership of the late Dr. Jerry Buss, the Lakers won ten championships, a run that included the fabled Showtime era that was inspired by Buss' vision that basketball games must be entertaining.



DAY 5: EVENING OUE SKYSPACE

OUE Skyspace Los Angeles is California's tallest open-air observation deck and a must-see destination for panoramic, 360-degree views of Los Angeles. Located nearly 1,000 feet above the city at the iconic U.S. Bank Tower in Downtown L.A., OUE Skyspace L.A. honors the culture, community and people that make Los Angeles unlike any city in the world.

Inside Incentive Tip:
The highlight of OUE Skyspace L.A. is the Skyslide, a first-of-its-kind outdoor glass slide that's attached to the exterior of the U.S. Bank Tower. The Skyslide is 45 feet long, about four feet wide and made entirely with 1.25-inch glass. Visitors will glide from the 70th to the 69th floor of the U.S. Bank Tower and see Los Angeles in a way that few will ever experience.



DAY 6: DAY TRIP TO CATALINA ISLAND

Discover paradise on Catalina Island, where endless crystal-clear waters and dramatic vistas surround you. With its Mediterranean climate and plenty of activities to enjoy, it's no wonder more than one million travelers choose Catalina Island as their getaway each year. Catalina Island can be enjoyed for the day or an overnight stay. Fast boats make the trip in about an hour and operate every day, year-round from three mainland ports.



DAY 6: ZIP LINE ECO TOUR

Get ready for two hours of adrenaline-fueled fun on TripAdvisor's top-rated Catalina Island adventure. After a brief safety session, you'll gear up and climb aboard a shuttle that will take you to the ridge top 600 feet above Descanso Beach Club. From there, you'll enjoy sweeping ocean views as you zigzag down and across the canyon and through a grove of towering eucalyptus trees on five separate lines at speeds approaching 35 mph.

Along the way, your trained guides will share interesting facts about the island's flora and fauna, which includes more than 60 species found only on Catalina Island. The tour ends at picturesque Descanso Beach Club, where you can share your Zip Line experiences with friends over signature food and drinks at Avalon's only beachside restaurant and bar.



DAY 6: EAST END ADVENTURE

There's nothing like an exciting journey through Catalina's pristine wilderness aboard an open-air biofuel Hummer. You'll get an intimate feel for Catalina's unique topography as you cruise the ridge around rugged canyons up to 1,500-foot East Peak.

From there, you'll travel along Divide Road, where you'll enjoy incredible ocean and canyon views of both sides of the island. You might even spot a bison or two on this unforgettable 4-wheeling adventure.

Experience underwater sights from aboard the Sea Wolf Semi-Submersible on Catalina Island. You'll see an incredible array of undersea dwellers: bright orange garibaldi, spotted calico bass, urchins, rock fish and bat rays, just to name a few.



DAY 6: CAPE CANYON EXPEDITION

Climb aboard an open-air biofuel Hummer and go in search of Catalina's world-famous bison on this exciting expedition into the island's interior. Descendants of a small herd left on the island by a movie crew in the 1920s, Catalina bison now number about 200 and are managed by the Catalina Island Conservancy.

Bison Expedition takes you to Middle Ranch, up Cape Canyon to a scenic overlook on Black Jack Mountain, and then down the original 19th-century stagecoach route back to Avalon. Along the way, you'll journey through favorite bison grazing grounds, where you'll have an excellent opportunity to see these majestic animals in the wild. It's a unique experience you'll only find on Catalina Island.



DAY 6: KAYAK & STAND-UP PADDLEBOARDING

Catalina Island's 52 miles of coastline invite exploration and kayaking is the ultimate way to do it. Beginners discover the ease of paddling along the leeward side of the island and more experienced paddlers can challenge themselves with longer expeditions. Guided tours are available from a number of providers and are a great way to learn more about the island while kayaking on Catalina.

Stand-up paddleboarding has taken the country by storm and it's not difficult to see why. Paddleboarding around Catalina Island offers miles of scenic coastline, isolated coves and compelling marine life to discover.
