Weather:

San Francisco's climate is, if nothing else, dependably changeable. Temperatures and conditions change literally by the hour and can differ markedly from one part of the city to the other. Yet overall, the City by the Bay enjoys an eternally spring-like climate. If you just walk a block or two, it could be completely different weather. San Francisco is famous for its micro-climates and the famous fog usually doesn't linger for long and temperatures seldom rise above a temperate 70 degrees.

Fun Facts:

The color of the Golden Gate Bridge is called International Orange. It wasn't a color from the original list of options. It was the primer used to protect the steel for the bridge during transit and the architect loved it more than the other options, so he selected it as the official color.

The Chinese fortune cookie was invented by a Japanese resident of San Francisco. Lombard Street gets all the love, but Filbert St. between Hyde and Leavenworth Streets is the steepest—31.5 degrees!

When Al Capone was held at Alcatraz, he gave regular Sunday concerts with the inmate band, the Rock Islanders. He played the banjo.

The city's cable cars are the only National Historical Monument that can move.






DAY 1: DINNER OPTION JOHN'S GRILL Location: Union Square



DAY 2: LUNCH BUBBA GUMP SHRIMP

DAY 2: EXCURSION ALCATRAZ

Visitors can walk in the footsteps of Al Capone and Machine Gun Kelly, and see the cell where the Birdman spent his time. See the first lighthouse on the West Coast and learn about Alcatraz as a Civil War fort. Explore the natural side of the Rock with beautiful gardens, bird colonies, and breathtaking views.

DAY 2: OPTIONAL: SAILING CHARTER

Sail up the city front and out into the bay towards Alcatraz in this 90-passenger catamaran that allows to carry large groups in comfort. The sailboat offers a large cockpit slightly recessed into the center of the boat, a design perfect for keeping the passengers in the sun but out of the wind.

Optional: Add lunch on boat or stop at Angel Island for BBQ

DAY 2: OPTIONAL BIKE TOUR OVER GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE

The first part of the ride follows the bay passing down the Marina District. Next, the mighty Golden Gate Bridge shows its bright orange color. After a brief photo stop, climb up some low hills to get to the entrance of the bridge. Arriving at the North side of the bridge, you'll stop again to enjoy the breath taking views of the bridge and the City of San Francisco. From this viewpoint you will continue down hill to the quaint city of Sausalito. Take the ferry back to Fisherman's Wharf in San Francisco

DAY 2: ART TOUR IN MISSION DISTRICT

With more than 200 murals canvasing its walls and back alleys, the Mission District is the city's mecca for political, cultural and just downright beautiful street art. Since 1977, the artists at Precita Eyes Mural Arts Center have created and preserved many of the stunning works. Your guided mural walk leads through the Mission, reflecting on the changing cultural and physical landscape and telling the stories behind the art, which reflect the area's Hispanic heritage and immigrant experience.

Duration: 2 hours

Description: The tour starts with a presentation about the history of muralism as well as a look at contemporary murals and the artists who create them, including spray can murals. This is followed by a guided walk with a Muralist.

DAY 3: FULL DAY NAPA VALLEY

Today the group will explore the world famous wine country: Napa Valley. Roughly 90 minutes drive north of San Francisco and boasting more than 400 wineries, Napa Valley is a connoisseur's paradise, inviting visitors to explore beyond the region's signature Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay. Visit two different wineries in Napa Valley. Enjoy a private tour that follows the path of the grapes from the vineyard through the cellar to the finished wine. See the inner workings of winery and learn about wine growing, fermentation, barrel aging and bottling.

DAY 3: V. SATTUI WINERY

V. Sattui Winery is a family-owned property located in the heart of Napa Valley, which was founded in 1885 and makes more than 60 different wines with dozens of 90+ point rated wines among its current vintages. It is a stunning, must-see Napa Valley destination. The sprawling estate includes two-dozen picnic tables nestled beneath ancient Valley Oak trees and tri-level terraces that overlook beautifully manicured gardens and vineyards.

We would break the group into smaller groups for the tour of the winery including estate vineyards, crush pad, production area, fermentation tanks, etc. We can do it simultaneously and just have them rotate their areas. Following the tour, your group would be set up in their own secluded area at the Vittorio lawn, where the group can dine amongst the vineyards. The group would be seated at round tables of 8 guests each. The group would then enjoy their lunch along with the wine tasting of 5 wines which would be led by multiple wine educators. Optional they could also set up casual lawn games in this area (cornhole, oversize Jenga and croquet). The group would have up to 2.5 hours total for the space and the tour and luncheon would take a little under 2 hours.




DAY 3: MONDAVI WINERY

A sprawling California Mission-style structure with graceful arches and an expansive courtyard in Oakville in the Napa valley, Robert Mondavi Winery offers one of the most comprehensive tour programs in the industry. Also on view is the permanent art collection throughout the winery grounds.

The group will have lunch in the Vineyard Room: Margrit Biever Mondavi's dream to show wine with art and food is brought to life in the Vineyard Room. Surrounded by the art of a featured artist, guests will enjoy a three course lunch menu with wine paired at each course. The chef uses produce from their own kitchen garden, and works closely with local vendors to ensure the freshest, highest quality of ingredients are used in our menus. Every detail in the Vineyard Room is thoughtfully tended to create an ambience of elegant grace. Crisp white linen, Riedel crystal stemware, silver and china, seasonal fresh flowers are all in place, ready to welcome your most important guests.

Tour the winery on a 30-60 minute and visit the vineyard and the cellar.






DAY 3: SAUSALITO

Just across the Golden Gate Bridge from the city of San Francisco, sits the world-renowned waterfront community of Sausalito. Perfectly arranged on a secure little harbor on the bay, Sausalito is undeniably lovely. Named for the tiny willows that once populated the banks of its creeks, it's famous for its colorful houseboats bobbing in the bay. Much of the well-heeled downtown has uninterrupted views of San Francisco and Angel Island, and due to the ridgeline at its back, fog generally skips it.

Guests can explore the town and then take a scenic ferry ride back to San Francisco Fisherman's Wharf. Guests can take the bus or cable car back to the hotel

SILICON VALLEY

It looks like a sleepy valley at first glance: low-rise buildings, boulders placed just so on corporate lawns, but make no mistake, this is Silicon Valley, the capital of the high tech world. Much of the South Bay is steeped in innovation, from the venture capital firms along Sand Hill Road in Menlo Park to the manicured Stanford University campus in Palo Alto. Scientific progress is celebrated in San Jose's Tech Museum of Innovation and enjoyable kitschy suspense is generated in the Winchester Mystery House with its trap doors and secret passageways. Here also is the new home of the San Francisco 49ers, Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara.

Weather:

Want to beat the heat but stay in the sunshine and mild temperatures? The average annual temperature is a pleasant 68 degrees (summer highs rarely over 78 degrees and winter lows in the mid-50s). Average rainfall is approximately 20 inches per year, occurring primarily from December to March.
