California Adventure Trip

Take in some of the most breathtaking and adventurous regions in the United States! This trip will cover the quintessential areas of northern California.

San Francisco will be the start and finish of the tour. In between you will raft the mighty American River, play in the turquoise waters of Lake Tahoe, and experience the grandeur of Yosemite Valley.



Trip Overview

San Francisco

- Arrive via airport
- Option to explore the city
- Hotel: The Marker
- Drive to rafting departure point (approx. 3 hour, 140 miles)

Rafting Tour

- Various half day and full day rafting options are available offering a wide variety of rapids
- Drive to Lake Tahoe hotel (approx. 1.5 hour, 70 miles)

Lake Tahoe

- Activities can include mountain biking tour, hiking, kayak tour, off road tour, sailing/boat tour, star gazing
- Hotel: Hard Rock Hotel
- Drive to Yosemite Valley (approx. 5 hour, 215 miles)

Yosemite Valley

- Activities can include rock climbing, hiking, guided national park ranger tours
- Hotel: Tenaya Lodge
- Drive to San Francisco (approx. 4 hour, 200 miles)



Day 1 - Arrival

Take the day to explore San Francisco and get a good night sleep before tomorrow's big raft trip!

Never the same. Always San Francisco. No matter if this is your first time to visit San Francisco, or you're here to renew an old acquaintance, the city never ceases to surprise.

Here are some of our favorite San Francisco options.



City Tour by Cable Car Bus

- Some favorite stops to visit: Union Square: San Francisco's central shopping district, Civic Center & Town Hall, Chinatown: visit fortune cookie factory, Lombard Street, 360 Degrees of the city from Twin Peaks
- Cable car accommodates up to 34pax (several available)
- Tour Duration: 3-4 hours

Bike Tour Over Golden Gate Bridge

- The mighty Golden Gate Bridge shows its bright orange color. After a brief photo stop, climb up some low hills to get to the entrance of the bridge. Arriving at the North side of the bridge, you'll stop again to enjoy the breath taking views of the bridge and the City of San Francisco. From this viewpoint you will continue down hill to the quaint city of Sausalito. Take the ferry back to Fisherman's Wharf in San Francisco
- Duration: 3 hours
- Distance: 8 miles (to Sausalito)

Angler Restaurant

Angler is a sea-life focused restaurant located on the Embarcadero waterfront. Each day's inspiration is drawn from the products themselves and is an articulation of their natural flavors, served at their peak taste. They work with a small group of fishermen, hunters, gatherers, ranchers, and farmers to find and follow microclimates that produce the highest quality products in local existence.



Day 2 - Rafting Tour

Get on the water and see why the American River is one of the best rivers in America to raft on!

Various rafting options are available to accommodate rapid strength, tour duration and difficulty.

Here are some example excursions.



Chili Bar – Half Day Trip

- 6-mile long non-stop action rafting trip with thrilling Class 2/3 rapids that are perfect for every level of rafter, from beginner to experienced, from youth groups to corporate groups. This three hour half-day rafting trip will give you about two hours of river time during which time you will be getting wet, hooting and hollering, paddling and laughing your way down rapids like Meatgrinder, Triple Threat, Maya culminating with Troublemaker Rapid – the biggest Class 3 rapid on the South Fork of the American.

Lower Gorge Express – Half Day Trip

- 15-mile long afternoon half-day rafting trip begins just below Troublemaker Rapid and once on the river you'll raft past James Marshall Gold Discovery State Park, where gold was discovered in 1848! This approximately four hour long, half-day river rafting trip will give you about three solid hours of river time during which time you will be relaxing and soaking up the sun, as well as paddling through fun and exciting rapids in the gorge.

Middle Fork – Day Trip

- The Middle Fork of the American River is one of the best full day rafting trips in California if not the West Coast! It's a true wilderness rafting experience, secluded timeless beauty full of human history from the Gold Rush era along with some of the biggest rapids rafted in California. This trip will give you about 5 hours on the river and includes a deli style lunch.



Day 3 - Lake Tahoe

Shimmering in myriad shades of blue and green, Lake Tahoe is the USA's second-deepest lake and, at 6245ft high, it is also one of the highest-elevation lakes in the country.

Here are some of our favorite Lake Tahoe adventure options!



Mountain Biking Tour


- Lake Tahoe's world famous Flume Trail is not to be missed! This classic ride begins at Spooner Lake
- The ride begins with a 4 mile climb to the Marlette Lake lookout. This dirt forest service road is very scenic and runs past an old shepherd's hut before becoming rolling uphill terrain through beautiful aspen groves. From here, it is all downhill to Marlette Lake and onto the Flume Trail proper. The riding is fast and the views are spectacular!
- Duration: 12 miles, 4 hours

Kayak Tour

- Kayak adventure starts at Sand Harbor on Tahoe's East Shore and first covers a comprehensive kayak lesson on the beach. Once on the water, you'll paddle along the coastline, soaking up the incredible Sierra views. Your guide will explain the geology, ecology, and natural and human history of the lake throughout your trip.
- Duration: 3-4 miles, 4 hours

Star Gazing

- The Dark Skies Cosmoarium is located in the Castle Peak area of Northstar California Ski Resort features choreographed astronomy shows and docent guided viewing through computerized Celestron telescopes
- Has an elevation of 6400 feet with unobstructed horizons
- Duration: 2.5 hours



Day 4 - Yosemite Valley

Not just a great valley, but a shrine to human foresight, the strength of granite, the power of glaciers, the persistence of life, and the tranquility of the High Sierra.

First protected in 1864, Yosemite National Park is best known for its waterfalls, but within its nearly 1,200 square miles, you can find deep valleys, grand meadows, ancient giant sequoias, a vast wilderness area, and much more.



Rock Climbing

- Come experience the scenic crags and domes of the southern Yosemite high country. This incredible area grants you access to more than 1,000 different climbs including Fresno Dome, Shuteye Ridge and The Balls areas. Whether its sport, trad, top-roping or multi-pitch routes, the area has lots to offer in all climbing styles. Your guide will ask you about your experience, skills, and goals for the day and choose routes most appropriate for your interests and ability.
- Duration: 4 hours

Vernal & Nevada Falls Hike

- Beginning at Happy Isles in the eastern end of Yosemite Valley, the trail climbs above the cataracts and rapids of the Merced River. The next half mile is where the Mist Trail earns its name. Steep and slick, the trail ascends a virtual granite stairway through the thundering mist of Vernal Fall. Once above the fall, the trail dries out as it continues past beautiful Emerald Pool and the Silver Apron to a final steep climb to the top of Nevada Fall.
- Duration: 4-6 hours

Half Dome All Day Hike

- Looming 4,800 feet above Yosemite Valley is the "Crown Jewel" of the Sierra, Half Dome. At over 17 miles round-trip and with thousands of feet in elevation gain and loss, a day-trip to the summit is certainly not a giveaway. For those that complete the journey, the spectacular views of Yosemite Valley and the Yosemite High Country are worth every hard-earned step
