

EXCURSION TO RONDA



Ronda retains much of its historic charm. This place is famous worldwide for its dramatic views and the *El Tajo* gorge through which the River Guadalevín flows. The 18th century Puente Nuevo, which straddles the 100m gorge, is a must for visitors for its unparalleled views.

The drive up from the coast is through the impressive *Serrania de Ronda* mountain range. On arrival, there is a short walking tour including a visit to the “Tajo” gorges, the famous bullring, one of the oldest in Spain, which also houses a museum as well as the church.

This tour includes: transportation by motor coach, multilingual guide, entrance fee to Ronda’s Bullring and Cathedral

A suitable lunch option and activity to combine with this visit of Ronda: a visit to an ecological wine bodega in the surroundings of Ronda (see next page).





A visit to an ecological “Bodega” situated in the stunning mountain range surrounding Ronda – the Serrania de Ronda - is very special indeed. Close to the bustling Costa del Sol, yet remote in its tranquil, amazing setting. On arrival at the “Bodega” from the outside patio, there are stunning and truly breath-taking views of the Serrania de Ronda.

The visit starts with a walking tour around the vineyard where your guide will explain a little about the different varieties of grape, methods of cultivation and the wine that is subsequently produced.

After a brief tour of the Bodega itself, it’s time to taste the wines and enjoy a variety of tapas. A countryside lunch or dinner will be offered in the winery (the owner is specialized in “country rice” cooking)
