<b>DAY 1</b>	WARSAW TASHKENT	FLIGHT LO 191 BUS  B	<p>Arrival Tashkent at 01:10+1AM from Warsaw. Meeting and greeting at the airport. Transfer to the hotel, check-in on arrival, time for rest.</p> <p>Breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p>Excursion along the new part of the city by visiting <b>Sacred Heart Parish Church</b> along with <b>the Monument to Polish Soldiers</b>. Continue excursion: Independence Square, Amir Temur Statue, Monument of Courage, Memorial to the World War II Victims, Alisher Navoi Theatre Square, Tashkent TV tower (outside)</p> <p>Excursion through the old part of Tashkent: Khazrati Imam Complex consisting of Barak Khan Madrasah (XVI c.), Kaffal Shashi Mausoleum (XV c.), Muyi-Mubarak Mosque – storehouse of the well-known Koran of Khalif Osman and gold hair of Prophet Muhammad, Djuma Mosque of Khodja Akhrar Vali; Kukeldash Madrasah (XVI c.).</p> <p>Free time for purchases in CHORSU bazaar and souvenir shops.</p> <p>Overnight at the hotel.</p>
<b>DAY 2</b>	TASHKENT URGENCH KHIVA	FLIGHT BUS  B	<p>Breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p>Transfer to Tashkent Domestic Airport. Morning flight HY-1051 to Urgench (07:25/08:55) <i>time is subject to change</i></p> <p><b>Caravans come to China from West to East and our route starts from Khiva, museum city under the sky.</b></p> <p>On arrival Urgench, meeting at the airport and drive towards <b>Anna German Street</b>. Unfortunately, the house where she lived is already destroyed, but there is a school where she studied.</p> <p>Further drive to Khiva (30 km). Transfer to the hotel, check-in and time for freshen up.</p> <p>Afternoon excursion along the historical complex Ichan-Kala (XII-XIX cc.) that is included into the UNESCO World Heritage List: Citadel Kunya-Ark (XVI-XVI cc.), Muhammad Amin Khan Madrasah, Kazi Kalon Madrasah, Muhammad Rakhimkhan II Madrasah, Ismail Khodja Mausoleum, Sayid Allauddin Mausoleum, Kalta Minor Tower, Tash-Khovli Palace (XIX c.), Palvan Darvaza (Warriors Gate), Djuma Mosque (X c.), Allakulikhan Madrasah, Ota Darvaza (Father Gate), Kutlug Murad Inaq Madrasah, Tash Khaulil Palace.</p> <p>Overnight at the hotel.</p>



<p><b>DAY 3</b></p>	<p>KHIVA BUKHARA</p>	<p>BUS 440 km</p> <p>B</p>	<p>Breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p><i>In old days, route from Khiva to Bukhara lasted more than a month. Today it takes 6-7 hours by vehicle, through mysterious red desert “Kyzyl-Kum”, the territory of “Khorezm”, which was called in the past as a “State of Thousand and Hundred Cities”. What kind of secrets are buried in this desert, this is something what archeologists and historians will be trying to find in the future. Meanwhile, you are invited to view the exotic landscapes of desert with roaming camels, nomadic yurts and old Amudarya River (Oxus).</i></p> <p><b>10:00</b> departure to Bukhara. <b>Around 17:00</b> arrival to Bukhara, check-in to the hotel.</p> <p><i>Holy Bukhara, homeland of Ibn Sino (Avicenna), loved city of all saints and worldwide known philosopher – cheery Hodja Nasriddin, lively, noisy and luxurious capital of Emirs, rich man of all nationals and patrons. When you hear “Splendor of East” – it is Bukhara!</i></p> <p>Overnight at the hotel.</p>
<p><b>DAY 4</b></p>	<p>BUKHARA</p>	<p>BUS</p> <p>B</p>	<p>Breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p>City tour in Bukhara: Citadel Ark (4<sup>th</sup> c. BC), Samanides Mausoleum (9-10<sup>th</sup> c.), Chashma Ayub (14<sup>th</sup> c.), Bolo-Hauz Mosque (beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> c.), Coumpol bazaar, Medreseh Nodir-Divan-Beghi, complex Lyabi-Khauz (14-17<sup>th</sup> c.), Minaret Kalon (12<sup>th</sup> c.), Kalyan Mosque (12<sup>th</sup> c.), Medreseh Miri Arab (16<sup>th</sup> c.).</p> <p>After dinner short walking around narrow streets of ancient Bukhara Overnight at the hotel.</p>
<p><b>DAY 5</b></p>	<p>BUKHARA</p>	<p>BUS</p> <p>B</p>	<p>Breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p><b>10:00</b> A trip out of the city for a visit to Bahouddin Nakshbandi mausoleum (16-19<sup>th</sup> c.), to the sepulchers of his mother and his preceptor (14<sup>th</sup> c.), mausoleum Chor-Bakr (10<sup>th</sup> c.), visit to summer residence Sitorai-Mokhi-Hossa (19<sup>th</sup> c.).</p>  <p>Overnight at the hotel.</p>
<p><b>DAY 6</b></p>	<p>BUKHARA SHAKHRISABZ SAMARKAND</p>	<p>BUS</p> <p>B</p>	<p>Breakfast at the hotel.</p> <p>Drive to Shakhrisabz (3 hrs.). On arrival, excursion along the city: Amir Temur's Ak-Saray Palace (White palace, 1380-1404), which is substantially destroyed, but it's restoring intensively. Except huge 40-metre gate, you will see magnificent filigree mosaics and unique technology samples of a wall. The ensemble of Mausoleum Dorus-Saodat ("Power Place", XIV c.) - crypt of Jahangir and Omar (Temur's sons). Cult places of Shakhrisabz are ensemble Dorut-Tilovat ("A blue mosque", XIV c.) - the mausoleum of spiritual instructor Timur Shamsiddin Kulol, graceful Gumbazi-Seyidon Mausoleum (XVI c.), Kok-Gumbaz Mosque (1435), and Khazrat-Imam Mosque (XIV c.).</p> <p>Visit to the <b>Cemetery of Polish Soldiers of General Ander's Army</b> in Shakhrisabz.</p> <p>Continue drive to Samarkand. On arrival, transfer to the hotel, check-in and time for freshen up. Overnight at the hotel.</p>

<b>DAY 7</b>	SAMARKAND TASHKENT	BUS TRAIN  B	<p>Breakfast at the hotel. City tour in Samarkand: <b>Registan square</b> - Medreseh Ulughbek (15<sup>th</sup> c.), Medreseh Shir-Dor (17<sup>th</sup> c.), Medreseh Tilla-Kori (17<sup>th</sup> c.). <b>Ulughbek Observatory</b> (15<sup>th</sup> c.) it was built on hills in Samarkand suburb, it went down in history as one of the most important observatories of the Middle Ages. <b>Architectural complex Shakhi-Zindeh</b> (11-15<sup>th</sup> c.) - one of Samarkand most mysterious and inimitable architectural monuments, is located not far from the Bibi-Khanym Mosque <b>Mausoleum Guri Emir</b> - Tamerlane's Tomb (14-15<sup>th</sup> c.) <b>Bibi-Khanym Mosque</b> is a cathedral mosque which according to a legend was named after Amir Timur's beloved wife. Majestic blue domes of the Bibi-Khanym Mosque are a striking sight</p> <p>Transfer to train station and drive to Tashkent by high speed train Afrosiab. 17:00 – 19:10 or 17:30 – 19:40</p> <p>23:00 Transfer to Tashkent International Airport. NO HOTEL</p>
