Day 01; Wednesday; SPLIT arrival (-,-,D)

Arrival at airport Split. Meet your local English speaking assistance. Private coach transfer to the hotel Radisson Blu, Split. Welcome drink and check in. Welcome dinner in the local restaurant. Return transfer to the restaurant. Overnight at the hotel in Split.

Split is the largest and most important town in Dalmatia. Walking tour of historical center and remains of Diocletian's Palace (UNESCO World Heritage List since 1979), built between the late 3rd and the early 4th centuries A.D. The cathedral was built in the Middle Ages, reusing materials from the ancient mausoleum. Romanesque churches, medieval fortifications, 15th -century Gothic palaces and other palaces in Renaissance and Baroque style make up the rest of the protected area.



Day 02; Thursday; SPLIT – HVAR

SAILING SCHOOL (B,L,D)

Breakfast buffet at the hotel. Our sailing boats are moored at the hotel jetty, you enter the hotel lift straight from the jetty, and all the time you are surrounded by unparalleled beauty created by joint effort of Mother Nature and world-class designers. Meeting with crew/skipper in front of sailing boats, embarkation on Dufour Grand Large sailing boat followed by introduction to safety procedure and familiarization with the sailing boats, together with showing basic skills for yacht's maneuvering.

Have a walk to Meneghello's art gallery and restaurant. Dine under a bamboo roof, surrounded by plants and local arts and crafts that adorn the colorful walls. This unique setting, overlooking the bay, has a split level terrace for you to enjoy the panorama as you sip some of the best local wines made on sunny slopes of Hvar. While waiting for your meal to be served enjoy in the story of Maneghello family who owes most of Palmizana and who made this place a real paradise.

After lunch sail to city of Hvar, a unique fusion of luxurious Mediterranean nature, rich cultural and historical heritage.



Hvar

Hvar gained glory and power during Middle Ages being an important port within the Venetian naval empire. Today, it is the center of the island's tourism and one of the favorite destinations in the Dalmatian Riviera. Go to Pjaca – the largest square in Dalmatia, explore the first public European theater and the renaissance Cathedral of St. Stephen. Time for coffee in one of the numerous coffee bars on the main square.

Visit also the Fortress "Espanjola" built in 16th century situated 88 meters above the town.

From this point the whole town and the Pakleni Archipelago can be seen which consists eleven islets that guard access to the town port.

Berth in front of the hotel. Check in and welcome drink and the Top bar of hotel Adriana. Walk to the local restaurant for dinner. Overnight at the hotel in Hvar.

Day 03; Friday; FD EXCURSION TO VIS (B,L,D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for morning sail direction the island of Vis with active participation of all crew members.

Stop in world-renowned Blue Cave, whose ethereal silvery blue color is created by the sun as it bathes the inside of the cave through an opening in the roof and is reflected back by the sandy surface below. Widely regarded as one of the world's most beautiful natural phenomena, this cave is a must see. Our trip continues to the legendary island of Vis and the authentic fishing village of Komiža or town Vis. Lunch in local restaurant. After free time sail back to Hvar. Walk to the local restaurant for dinner.

Overnight at the hotel in Hvar.



Day 04; Saturday

HD HVAR WINE TOUR AND FUN REGATTA (B,L,D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Late morning check out followed by visit of one of the Hvar's wine cellar

Winemaking on Hvar has been around for about 2000 years, with the Greeks bringing the knowledge of winegrowing while setting up a colony named Pharos (now called Stari Grad, the oldest town in Croatia).

Before boarding on the Yachts, stop at one of the hidden, unique places with domestic atmosphere for lunch.



On the way back to Split, Fun Regatta will be organized.

Arrival in front of the hotel Radisson Blu, Split. Check in and get ready for farewell dinner in local restaurant. Return transfer to restaurant.

Overnight at the hotel in Split.

Day 05; Sunday SPLIT - departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Check out and transfer to airport Split for your flight back home.
