Megaliths, Medieval dungeons and Calypso's Cave – The Maltese Islands are positively mythic. The narrow meandering streets of their towns and villages, always leading to a huge Baroque church, are a sight to behold. Their Fortress Cities are architectural marvels and the countryside is dotted with medieval towers, wayside chapels and the oldest known human structures in the world. The Islands have been described as an open-air museum.

The Maltese archipelago lies virtually at the centre of the Mediterranean, 93 km south of Sicily and 288 km north of Africa. It consists of three islands: Malta, Gozo and Comino. Malta is the largest island and the cultural, commercial and administrative centre; Gozo is the second largest island and is more rural: characterised by fishing, tourism, crafts and agriculture. Comino, the smallest of the trio, is famous for its crystal-clear waters and is largely uninhabited. With a 7000 year history of colonization and attempted invasion, superb weather, beautiful beaches and a thriving nightlife, there is a great deal to see and do...

In Malta's modest dimensions lies its greatest charm. Every nook offers a swift journey from coastal splendor to historic gem.








100 WAYS OF FISH

EXPLORE VALLETTA | The Capital




'Built by Gentlemen for Gentlemen'

Explore the capital Valletta and discover why UNESCO named it a World Heritage Site with 'one of the most concentrated historic areas in the world'.

Built as a City Fortress and established in the 16th Century by the Knights of St. John, the city is surrounded by massive bastion walls which conceal the stunning Baroque palaces, gardens and churches within.

Valletta's beauty and charm led the ruling houses of Europe to give the city its nickname *Superbissima* -Latin for "Most Proud".




ST. JOHN'S CO-CATHEDRAL



VALLETTA'S JEWEL IN THE CROWN

Built in 1573, every wall and pillar of St. John's Co-Cathedral is encrusted with rich ornamentation, gold leaf and **priceless masterpieces by Caravaggio**. Even the floor is an iridescent patchwork quilt of marble tomb slabs and the vault dances with paintings by Mattia Preti. The Cathedral also hides a mysterious crypt containing the tombs of Grand Masters.

The church is considered to be one of the finest examples of high Baroque architecture in Europe and one of the world's great cathedrals. St. John's Cathedral is a must.

THE OLD WAYS...





MALTESE HOSPITALITY

Situated in the medieval baker's village of Casal Curmi il-Fornaro (today Hal-Qormi), Razzett L-Antik is set in what was once a milling factory to grind grain to flour for the daily bread and is over 400 years old. The medieval milling room is now set up for the two cooking schools and for gourmet and private dining.

The restaurant is dedicated to over 1000 years of Maltese food and culinary heritage, specialising in the traditional art of slow food farmhouse cooking. The service is unique: servers are dressed in full period costume which making Razzett L-Antik the ideal venue to appreciate traditional Maltese hospitality and culinary delights.

Malta's terrain leads to some incredible scenic routes for bikers to get their hands – or wheels – all over.

Biking is increasingly popular with locals and visitors alike. The island has a great deal to offer the cyclist, from rough walled alleyways and off-road tracks to long smooth roads where you can really pick up a good rhythm, there are a great number of cycling routes offering physical and technical challenges, as well as the brand new cycle route that circumnavigates the island.

Mountain biking is at its best in the mild winter months from October to May, when temperatures are mild and the island is a lush green carpet of wild flowers and scented herbs. If you don't mind working up a sweat, however, Malta welcomes cyclists at any time of year.

Three is the magic number when it comes to thrilling adventures




How it works


MDINA BY NIGHT BEFORE DINNER & BASTION APERITIVE


SURPRISE CONCERT AT THE CATHEDRAL




EXPERIENCE AN EXCLUSIVE PRIVATE CONCERT


DINE UNDER THE VINES IN MDINA
