Megaliths, Medieval dungeons and Calypso's Cave – The Maltese Islands are positively mythic. The narrow meandering streets of their towns and villages, always leading to a huge Baroque church, are a sight to behold. Their Fortress Cities are architectural marvels and the countryside is dotted with medieval towers, wayside chapels and the oldest known human structures in the world. The Islands have been described as an open-air museum.

The Maltese archipelago lies virtually at the centre of the Mediterranean, 93 km south of Sicily and 288 km north of Africa. It consists of three islands: Malta, Gozo and Comino.

Malta is the largest island and the cultural, commercial and administrative centre; Gozo is the second largest island and is more rural: characterised by fishing, tourism, crafts and agriculture. Comino, the smallest of the trio, is famous for its crystal-clear waters and is largely uninhabited. With a 7000 year history of colonization and attempted invasion, superb weather, beautiful beaches and a thriving nightlife, there is a great deal to see and do...



At night, the atmosphere changes and music is an integral part of the experience, so you can have a great time with your partner or a group of friends.






PICTURESQUE VIEWS

Situated by the sea in Spinola Bay, in the heart of St Julian's, San Giuliano offers a magnificent view of the picturesque bay that stretches to Sliema with floor-to-ceiling panoramic windows.

Located in and around the converted old boathouse built by the Knights of Malta in 1688, the San Giuliano restaurant serves Italian cuisine and is best known for its fresh fish. Fishermen bring their daily catch just below the restaurant and therefore a large choice is always available.

CHOPHOUSE RESTAURANT



EXQUISITE MEAT, DAZZLING VIEWS

Located in Sliema, The Chophouse is often considered Malta's leading meat restaurant: they butcher and hang most of it themselves, serving all cuts, from head to tail. Only the very best ingredients are used and cooked on the largest charcoal grill on the island. Their wines are also remarkable; one can browse from a selection of over 200, stored in a humidity and temperature controlled glass fronted 'cave'.

The Chophouse's views onto Valletta from across the bay are unique and absolutely stunning. The terrace seating is backed up by a large internal area with parquet flooring and fronted by 6m high glass windows, so that even in adverse weather the view of Valletta can still be enjoyed.




How it works



PARANGA RESTAURANT




100 WAYS OF FISH

Option 1: Explore Valletta

EXPLORE VALLETTA | The Capital



'Built by Gentlemen for Gentlemen'

Guests will be transferred to the capital Valletta and discover why UNESCO named Valletta a World Heritage Site and it described it as 'one of the most concentrated historic areas in the world'.

It was established in the 16th Century by the Knights of St. John and built as a city-fortress, surrounded by massive bastion walls which conceal the stunning Baroque palaces, gardens and churches within.

Valletta's beauty and charm led the ruling houses of Europe to give the city its nickname *Superbissima* -Latin for "Most Proud".




ST. JOHN'S CO-CATHEDRAL



VALLETTA'S JEWEL IN THE CROWN

Built in 1573, every wall and pillar of St. John's Co-Cathedral is encrusted with rich ornamentation, gold leaf and **priceless masterpieces by Caravaggio**. Even the floor is an iridescent patchwork quilt of marble tomb slabs and the vault dances with paintings by Mattia Preti. The Cathedral also hides a mysterious crypt containing the tombs of Grand Masters.

The church is considered to be one of the finest examples of high Baroque architecture in Europe and one of the world's great cathedrals. St. John's Cathedral is a must.



Optional: CASA ROCCA PICCOLA WITH CHAMPAGNE



HOUSE OF THE NOBLE FAMILY OF PIRO

Casa Rocca Piccola has more than 50 rooms, most of which are open to visitors. The palace offers a unique insight into the customs and traditions of the Maltese nobility over the past 400 years. We can see the vast collection of priceless furniture, silverware and paintings that are part of Malta's artistic heritage. The Second World War air raid shelters are a spectacular and exciting addition to the house tours.

Optional: guided tour generally organised by the Marquis de Piro, followed by a glass of champagne, either in the courtyard (weather permitting) or in one of the rooms on display.

TASTINGS IN THE CAFE CORDINA SQUARE - for example -

Wine tasting with Maltese nibbles, such as typical Maltese Gozo cheese among many others, Maltese olives and sun-dried tomatoes, accompanied by bread and crackers.

Maltese coffee and pastizzi - traditional Maltese favourite snacks to be enjoyed in the upper gardens of Barrakka, where guests can enjoy breathtaking views.

Cisk and twistees - Malta's famous beer and crunchy snack at the Triton Fountain.


Maltese ice cream or Maltese kannoli in the square.




MALTA'S ARTISTIC TREASURES

Located in the Auberge d'Italie, a 16th-century building once housing Italian members of the Knights of St John.



MDINA BY NIGHT BEFORE DINNER



The Centre of Maltese Nobility

The mysterious golden-stone fortress city of Mdina, nicknamed 'the Silent City', crowns a hilltop and is a world apart from modern Malta. Founded in 8th Century BC, the hidden lanes of Mdina offer exquisite architectural detail, and its massive walls provide fabulous views over Malta.

Guests will walk through the narrow streets of Mdina before dinner, when the ancient streets of this fortress are empty and almost eerily quiet. Led by a guide and (optionally: 2 torch bearers) who will deliver a quick brief of Mdina's incredible history. Guests will then enjoy a welcome drink atop of the awe-inspiring bastions built to repel invaders. Incredible panoramic views of Malta await guests before making their way to dinner.


EXPERIENCE AN EXCLUSIVE PRIVATE CONCERT




DINE UNDER THE VINES IN MDINA
